THIS SHEET CONTAINS UPDATED INFORMATION RELATED TO CHANGES TO THE 2020 SUNCOAST MUSIC SCHOLARSHIPS. Unfortunately, funding shortfall has necessitated a slight reduction in the awards available to current 12th grade students. Auditions for this year's 10th and 11th grade students have been canceled until further notice.

AWARDS

Awards for 12th grade students are to be used for expenses, ideally as tuition for a music program at a college or university, or for other expenses related to the study of music, such as paying for private lessons, instrument purchase or repair, music camp, etc.

1st Place - \$4,000
2nd Place - \$3,000
3rd Place - \$2,000
4th Place - \$1,000

AUDITIONS Auditions will be held on **Saturday, July 25, 2020**, at Church of the Redeemer, 222 S. Palm Avenue, Sarasota, from 1-5 PM. Applicants will be notified of the time for their scheduled audition.

Applicants are required to perform a minimum of two pieces of music which must be of contrasting styles and from different periods. Performance time must total no less than 4 minutes and no longer than 10 minutes.

All 12th grade applicants must bring an original copy and two photocopies of the music to be performed to the audition for the judges.

Judging will be based on Technique, Musicality and Presentation.

ACCOMPANISTS *** We need to know the name of your accompanist BEFORE we can schedule you for an audition, if you will have an accompanist for your audition. It is the applicant's responsibility to make arrangements with, rehearse with, and compensate the accompanist. (Contact us if you need a list of potential accompanists.)

Pre-recorded music is not preferred for accompaniment, but if it is to be used, a CD copy of the music must be included with the application form.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS & INFORMATION

Competition results will be announced via email at 12 p.m. on Monday, July 27.

Funds will be distributed directly to a school / teacher, or in response to a submitted and approved invoice.
